- There were 1,199 new CRNs issued during the racing year and 1,100 dogs earned their first points last racing year.

- 244 events ran the Open class with 1308 teams competing representing 2488 unique dogs.
- 14,455,269 points were earned last year
- 490,453 points were earned in the Vets class
- 2,256,443 points were earned in the Open class
- 83,908 points were earned at this year's Cynosports event
