II. Statistics

Lee reviewed some statistics from the 2013 racing year:

There were 357 events hosted in 40 states and provinces hosted by 140 different clubs.

9,155 teams raced in these events from 371 different clubs, with 4,202 total club entries.

4,734 teams raced in Regular 780 raced in Multibreed 344 raced in Vets 3,285 raced in Open The remainder were in miscellaneous classes.

7,767 new titles plus 178 Iron Dogs were earned during the racing year for a total of 7,945.

3,582 dogs earned titles were earned during the 2013 racing year.

15,598,160 points were earned during the racing year by 5,604 dogs from 155 different breeds (one breed being mix).

944 new dogs registered.

V. Question and Answer Session

Lee opened the meeting for questions.

Question: When is the Alaska tourney this summer? Curtis Smith addressed this question as his club hosts. The tourney is June 25 & 26, where there are lots of opportunities to race and lots of fun. This region (Region 19) has had very good representation from this region, Curtis mentions.

Question: Multibreed was a great addition to flyball. What's the "next big thing?"

Answer: Lee talked about how the multibreed titles were introduced and that they were instigated by members of the flyball community. One of our best assets is that we are willing to listen and would like to hear from the competitors. We try to give plenty of opportunities to suggest ideas to the board. So, please let us know of your ideas for "the next big thing."

Sam added that in the last couple of years NAFA has put focus on CanAm and now we have seven rings and that was unheard of in the past. We've also introduced the Honor Board to honor your past and present dogs, clubs and people where they are displayed on the CanAm jumps permanently.

Question: Will CanAm ever be in a different location?

Answer: We have researched but have not yet found a location that meets the criteria needed for the event to be held. With the growth and size (our current building is four acres), there aren't that many facilities that will support an event of this size. We are also building our vendor lists to help underwrite CanAm. And that base will help maintain as low a cost as possible. So timing and location all have to come together.
