### **Regulatory Committee**

Dear fellow flyballers,

I writing this to clarify a few things about a vital piece of equipment that is common at ALL tournaments, be they indoor or outdoor - The Flyball Box! Section 6.8 (e) of the Rule book states that the box:

- "Shall not exceed 24 inches in width" this IN-CLUDES any foam, rubber, carpet, carrying handles (permanently or non-permanently attached) that may stick out and exceed the dimension.
- "Shall not exceed 18 inches in height" this IN-CLUDES the trigger arms (cocking devices)
  AND the platform that the boxloader stands on but EXCLUDES mat grabbing devices, as long as such devices do not raise the box by more than one half inch (up to 18.5 inches). The box must meet this dimension while cocked, loaded and fired anytime during racing.
- "Shall not exceed 30 inches in depth" This is reserved for the BODY of the box only. The platform that the box loader stands on MAY be longer than 30 inches.

Any deviation from these dimensions will excuse your box from the competition.

#### **Notes from the Editor**

Connie Austin, has taken on the task of Sanctioning Tournaments for NAFA (Sanction Secretary) and I amher assistant. Here are a few words on the subject:

How do you get a tournament sanctioned?

1. Fill out the most up-to-date form on the Web Site (www.flyball.org) for sanctioning. It will include questions about

- Judges, Location of the tournament, Tournament Director, Tournament Chair, Fees, runback space, etc.. Mail that form to the NAFA address.
- 2. For those that want to correspond via email I can send you a copy of the form (in Microsoft WORD format curace@earthlink.net) to return to me as an attachment to the e-mail. It is easier for me to enter the information into the database when the correct form is used and completed filled out. I will be able to serve you better by providing accurate and up-to-date information. Please do not send in the form until you have all the required fields (listed with an asterisk).

#### How do I fill out the form?

- Under location please fill out the actual site and the city, state. For instance, "Grover Fairgrounds, Grover, Massachusetts"
- 2. Date(s): List the dates of your tournament(s), start date and end date. For instance if you have a tournament on Friday and one on Sat/Sun. List all three dates. Under CLASSES there are two columns. Fill out the first column if you have a regular tournament over two days. If instead you have a regular tournament on Sat and a separate one on Sunday you will fill out both columns. The same with 4breed. If there are separate tournaments over several days they should each take up a column. Feel free to explain if you think it is confusing under Special Rules at the bottom.
- 3. Host Flyball Club: You must have a club registered with NAFA to put on a NAFA sanctioned tournament.
- 4. Tournament Director: Please provide complete information (hopefully with e-

- mail address in case further clarification by the secretary is needed).
- 5. NAFA EJS: list whether you need a set of NAFA EJS's and how many you are requesting and provide information on which airport you want them to arrive at
- 6. Please provide info on Running surface, runback area, prizes/ribbons

What information must you have before your tournament can be sanctioned?

- 1. You must have all the required information (marked with an asterisk). You must have the head judge and a team name registered with NAFA listed on the form. Without the asterisked information your form will be sent back to you.
- 2. The form must be filled out completely and accurately. When you make changes the entire form must be re-entered so please try to send in the correct information the first time around.

How long before my tournament do I need to get my form in for sanctioning?

1. The form must arrive at NAFA by 60 days before your closing date if it is an unlimited tournament and 90 days before the tournament closing date if limited. Please send in at least 2 weeks before these dates.

What if another team wants to have a tournament the same weekend within 300 miles of mine?

1. If your Club had that same time period last year, your Club has priority over any other Club within 300 miles from the site of your Club's tournament. If your Club has not yet sanctioned a tournament for this year and another Club wants "your weekend", your Club must give permission to allow the other Club to use your weekend. If your Club has a sanctioned tournament already approved for this year and another Club wants to hold a tourn ament that same weekend, within 300 miles of your site, the other Club must have your permission before the secretary can sanction the other Club's tourn ament.

How can I be sure I will get my EJS light sets?

 Sanctioning is separate from EJS lights. Because tournaments can be held without lights, tournaments will be sanctioned without regard to whether lights will definitely be available.

What will I receive after my tournament is sanctioned?

- 1. If you listed an e-mail address you will receive an e-mail note asking you to check the information on the web site to be sure it appears as you want it.
- 2. Then you will receive a packet in the mail within a few weeks which provides you with a copy of each form you will need for your tournament and a mailing form that you will use to send your results back to NAFA.

I have attached all the new forms (C.3, C.6 & C.8) and the revised racing formats (9 Team Round Robin & 7 Team Double Elimination) in this NAFA News.

#### **Abridged Board Meeting Notes**

Las Vegas, NV 27 January, 2001

**Board Members Present:** Alan Weiner, Val Culpin, Ule James, Judy Hagan, Robin Marion, Sue Rogers, Dale Smith, Brett Williams. The Executive Director, Steve McAvoy was also present.

Board Members Absent: Marion Brinkman.

The meeting was called to order by Alan at 9:07 a.m.

Alan asked that the minutes of the last Board meeting on November 3, 2000 be reviewed for corrections and omissions. Dale made the motion to accept the minutes – seconded by Brett. – In favor: Dale, Brett, Sue, Val, and Robin. Ule & Judy abstained. Motion passed.

# **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT – Steve** McAvoy

Steve thanked everyone for their efforts on Friday and the work that was done on revamping of NAFA's bylaw's, Standing Rules, & Rules of Racing.

Steve talked about where competitors and judges have been going to get Rule Interpretations. He stated that the Regulatory Committee is in charge of interpreting the rules of flyball.

Steve has appointed Howard Bayerle as Interim Regional Director of Region 10. Steve is close to getting a replacement Regional Director for Regions 7 & 10.

Steve talked to the board about holding Judging Semi-

nar's. NAFA will pay for expenses of conducting the seminar only (Conference Room & Materials). Dale made the motion for NAFA to conduct a Judging Seminar. Brett seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Alan will add to the Petsmart budget. Steve & Ule will work to put the first one together.

#### **Secretary – Sue Rogers**

Sue stated that the United States Trademark Office has notified her that the NAFA Logo Trademark has been completed.

#### **Treasurer – Finance Report – Dale Smith**

Dale handed out the Account Balance Report as of 1/24/01. The books are being sent to the Accounting Firm within the next week for review. Once the review has occurred, the statement will be published in the NAFA News.

# Judges and Guidelines -Val, Robin, and Aaron Hughes

Val reports there are no new judges for approval, but stated she has several new apprentices coming up.

Val has a copy of the Judges Video for the board to review. It's approximately 40 minutes long. Val has also given a copy of the tape to Ken Eldridge to review.

#### Hall of Fame - Ule, Marion and Judy

Brett read the following proposal for a Regional Hall of Fame. –

Section 4.1 - Clyde Moore Memorial Hall of Fame

NAFA may induct one dog per region per year into the Clyde Moore Memorial Hall of Fame. Using the following criteria, individuals are asked to nominate candidates that they consider deserving of this award:

- (1) Longevity: A dog must have raced in NAFA sanctioned events for a minimum of four (4) years;
- (2) (ii) Notoriety: How well known is this dog? Nominees should be easily recognizable within their own region;
- (3) (iii) Team value: What is the worth of this dog to its team, i.e. untiring start dog, height dog, most consistent dog, fast anchor dog. Although other titles and achievements may be included in the nomination, each dog will be judged on the above Flyball criteria only.

Submit a brief resume of two hundred (200) words or less to include the dog's name, CRN, breed, clubs raced with, and the reasons he or she deserves consideration. Each year all candidates will be judged by NAFA's Board of Directors in order of merit. A list of no more than five (5) finalists per region will be selected and put to a delegate vote of that dog's registered region. Submit nominations to NAFA by May 31st of each year by mailing to the NAFA Hall of Fame Committee at the published NAFA address. NAFA encourages anyone who feels that they have a dog worthy of recognition to keep photographs and mementos for future consideration and inclusion into the NAFA Hall of Fame.

During the Annual General Meeting the returned ballots will be tallied. Delegates will be allowed only one vote to cast for their region, and only their region. A maximum of one dog per region may be inducted into the Hall Of Fame. In order for a dog to qualify to be allowed into the Hall Of Fame the dog must earn 40% of the returned vote. In the case that more than one dog from a region earns more than 40% the dog with the higher percentage of returned votes will be inducted.

Ule made the motion to put the above proposal to delegate vote to create a Regional Hall of Fame. Dale seconded. In favor: Dale, Ule, Val, and Brett. Opposed – Sue, Judy, Robin, and Alan. Motion failed.

Brett will continue to work on this proposal for the next board meeting regarding concern of what affect the Regional Hall of Fame would have on the Clyde Moore Hall of Fame.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Herbert Wagner Award** - Dale & Brett could not find any information on Herbert Wagner that was concrete. They will continue to try to locate him.

tion of EJS light systems. Aaron showed the main controller of the tree and wicket. Software for the wicket (sensor uprights) is complete. Listed below are some of the basic features/options:

If one portion of the EJS fails – other portions will still work. Example, you could still time, but couldn't electronically judge passes or vice versa. EJS can operate with or without a laptop, able to work with or without large LED Displays. By making a single microchip change you can convert to work on a handicap system. Basic system allows for obtaining your start time (you will know how early you were), can also punch in break-out time and compare finish time with break-out time. You have to set for each division. Aaron feels he will have a set of lights up and running by the first part of April.

Aaron asked the board how/what we want displayed at the timing table and on the LED Displays. The technology committee will meet to discuss this. System is ready except for the clock. Clock takes the time – if I do this, then what happens. Hardware is easy part. The intent is for it to take no longer than 10 minutes to set-up the lights at each tournament. Packing boxes will be made to fit the lights.

It's clearly not our intent to mask over the 3<sup>rd</sup> digit. Dale and Aaron are working on this.

**Acquiring EJS (existing units)** – NAFA has no intention of purchasing any additional sets of existing EJS'. We have no one that can manufacturer them.

**Delegate Mailing** – Dale will have delegate information in the mail within the next 10 days.

**Supervising Head Judge Criteria -** Val made the motion to adopt the following minimum criteria for eligibility to become a Supervising Head Judge.

1. Prospective Judges must have been involved in the sport of flyball for a minimum of 5

- years, with at least 3 continuous years as a NAFA approved judge.
- 2. Prospective Judges must be in good standing with NAFA, with no letters of discipline, probation, or suspension in their records, dating back at least 5 years.
- 3. In the time the prospective judge has been judging, he or she must have judged a minimum of 25 tournaments on separate weekends, in order to gain the kind of experience required to supervise new judges.
- 4. Prospective judges must possess all of the best qualities one could want in a Supervising Judge fairness, firmness, safety minded, a good attitude to the sport, the participants, and the spectators, and a sense of responsibility to the sport and as a representative of NAFA.
- 5. Prospective Judges must be willing and able to mentor new and apprentice judges, answering questions, challenging apprentices, and generally overseeing the education of the new judge. The sharing of experiences and the ability to explain rulings and other nuances of the sport are an absolute must.
- 6. Prospective Judges must have excellent measuring skills since his or her measurement is the deciding factor for any height cards.
- 7. Prospective Judges for supervisory status may be proposed to the Board of Directors in writing by any Board member, judge, or participant in official NAFA events. Such proposal must be accompanied by the signatures of endorsement of at least 5 different tournament directors the applicant has judged for, 2 fellow NAFA approved judges, and the Regional Director for the applicant's home region.
- 8. It's understood that the meeting of all of the necessary criteria for Supervisory status does not mean an automatic approval by the Board of Directors. It's not the intention of the Board to appoint great numbers of Supervisory Judges in any area.

Dale seconded. In favor: Sue, Ule, Brett, Robin, Val, and Dale. Judy opposed. This will take effect immediately. Val and Sue will work to put together a Application form for the above. Add to Judges portion of Rules of Racing.

Val showed a proposed Head Judge Pin that she would like NAFA to have made and distributed to all Head Judges. The proposed pins did not have the official NAFA logo on it. Val is sending the pins back for redesign. Dale motioned that we order 100 of the redesigned pins – Brett seconded. The motion passed

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

**Letter from Ron English regarding multiple EJS light set priority** – The motion did not receive a second. Dale to respond to Ron.

**Letter from Sam Ford regarding teams holding back to circumvent breakout policy** – Assigned to Regulatory – Robin to respond to Sam.

Multiple height card signatures at the same tournament – Robin made the motion that height card signatures must come from a minimum of 3 separate tournaments. Sue seconded. In favor: Robin, Sue, and Brett. Opposed: Ule, Judy, Val, and Dale. Motion failed.

Judges signing their own teams' height card application – Robin made the motion that Judges can measure and sign their own teams height cards including their own dog's. Brett seconded. In favor: Ule, Brett and Robin. Opposed: Sue, Dale, Judy, & Val. Motion failed.

Four month policy/circumventing policy by dissol v-ing/reforming/waivers – Robin. The Regulatory Committee will propose a revision to the current policy at the next board meeting.

Letter from Johan de Kock (South Africa) re: the use of our rules and administrative system – Dale – We will allow them to use our rules for a fee of \$1.00.

Lights – They asked NAFA for a set of plans for current EJS. We have no plans to give them. We will put them in contact with Aaron Hughes to possibly buy plans or a set of lights. NAFA will sell them the rights to use our software for \$50.00.

Dale to respond.

The board entered Executive Session at 4:12 p.m. The board exited Executive Session at 4:50 p.m.

Letter regarding lane separation wording (EJS cables don't reach) – Dale made the motion to modify 6.13.b in the current Rules & Policies to read as follows: Racing lanes shall be a minimum of 12 feet from center to center and a maximum of 17. Robin seconded the motion. In favor – Dale, Judy, Robin, Brett, Val, and Sue. Ule opposed. The motion passed.

**Policy on compensating teams that use their own EJS.** - Dale will write an article for the NAFA News to further clarify.

**Letter from Phil Taylor regarding knocked out boards on world record runs**. If a board is knocked out causing 1 or more jumps to be at the incorrect jump height, the run will not be considered a record run. Val to respond.

Team forfeiting a race "to rest" and then competing to place – Dale – not allowed.

NAFA Communications sent to club owners only — Ule made the motion that NAFA reword Chapter 2 — Delegates 2.3 C. Teams that fail to provide delegate information by the date specified will have their delegates send to the club owner. Brett seconded. In favor: Brett, Ule, & Judy. Opposed: Sue, Val, Dale, and Robin. Motion failed.

NAFA Sanctioning Packets - Val stated concerns from teams in her area that NAFA Sanctioning Tournament Approval packets are not getting mailed out to teams after sanctioning. Steve announced that Connie Austin is taking over as Tournament Sanctioning Secretary effective immediately. We will continue to monitor the approval packet mailings.

**Award Levels** - Dale & Sue will investigate creating small plates that hang off of the current 30k (FGDCh plaque) with 40k, 50k, 60k, etc. including the date the milestone was achieved.

**Form used for Verification of World Records** – Marion – Ule will follow-up with Marion.

Letter from Daphne Tryhuk regarding Regional Director appointments and judge assistance – Motion did not receive a second. Robin to respond.

#### **Check the Data Base!**

If not correct notify NAFA.

Regulatory Committee will work on wording for protesting measurements that are listed on the tournaments Jump Height Form that is posted at each tournament.

Interference on own Team – Teams can't interfere with themselves – Val will write an article in the NAFA News.

Mat grabbing devices & outdoor staking devices -Robin will write an article for the NAFA News restating the size of boxes that are allowed in competition. There is some concern that the cocking mechanisms are making some boxes oversized.

Jump Board Thickness - Val made the motion that NAFA <u>requires</u> all 1 and 2-inch jump boards are no thicker than ½ inch plywood, sintra, or similar approved material by October 1, 2001. Brett seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Letter from Ron English asked that to be nominated into the Hall of Fame the dog must be deceased or permanently retired - The motion received no second. Dale to respond. Working on proposal for Regional Hall of Fame.
